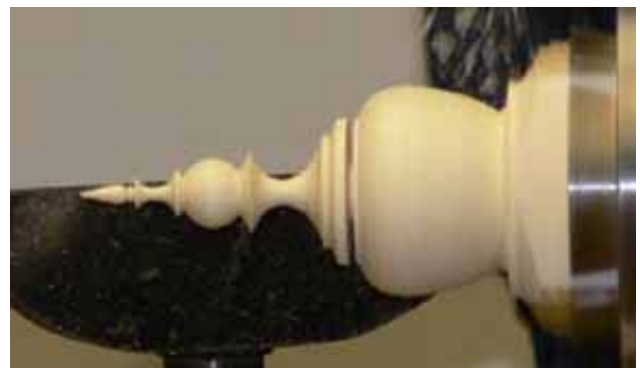
August Demo: Surprise

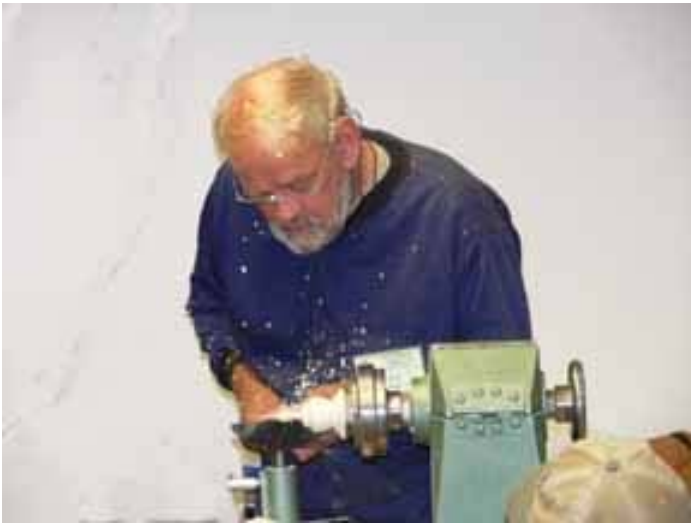
Since Max Krimmel is not able to present this month, David Nittmann is going to surprise us.
